



A FINAL SALUTE FOR A FALLEN COMRADE-----Full military honors were given at the final rites for Navy Hospital Corpsman Steven Paul Swatek, 20, who became Peshtigo's third Vietnam War casualty when he was killed by enemy fire during the battle of Hue on March 1. Steven Cox also of Peshtigo, is shown in the left photo, standing before the Doughboy of World War I at the Riverside Cemetery in Peshtigo, giving a final salute to his fallen comrade.
